Webinar 1: Site Specific Data Items for Case Abstracting: 2018 and Forward

The webinar will review the most recent updates for documenting and coding the Site-Specific Data Items (SSDIs) that were introduced for

2018+ case abstracting. Ruhl will also address issues about the SSDIs and Grade found during the recent SEER EOD/Summary Stage/SSDI and Grade Reliability Study.

Jennifer Ruhl, MSHCA, RHIT, CCS, CTR, is a Public Health Analyst in the Quality Control section of SEER and has been with them for 12 years. Ruhl is also the chair of the NAACCR SSDI Workgroup.

Webinar 2: Navigating the STORE Manual

The Standards for Oncology Registry Entry (STORE) Manual, released for cases diagnosed from January 1, 2018, is still raising questions among registrars regarding certain data items. The webinar will answer many of those questions using case examples to illustrate the correct application of data items.

Kelli Aimar, CTR, is the Cancer Registry Manager for HCA/Parallon. She has 10+ years of experience in registry operations, CoC and NAPBC accreditation, and managing quality control programs. Aimar is the former NCRA Advocacy Technical & Practice Board (ATPD) Director for the West. Amanda Lemons, RHIA, CTR, is the Cancer Registry Director for HCA/Parallon. She is responsible for assisting in the development of the overall strategy for the company's cancer registry and the daily operations for all HCA registry operations related to cancer reporting.

Webinar 3: Radiation Oncology for the Cancer Registrar: All You Need to Know

Tuesday, November 12, 2019; 2:00 PM – 3:00 PM ET

Presented by Jeffrey Brabham, MD, MBA

The STORE changes for coding radiation therapy treatments have increased the number of data fields to 31. Dr. Brabham will discuss problematic coding areas that will help registrars address the new challenges. The webinar will include discussion of radiation oncology nomenclature, phases of treatment, total dose and boost treatment, and other new data fields that may cause confusion.

Dr. Brabham received an undergraduate degree in history from Dartmouth College and his medical degree from the University of Florida. He completed both his internships in internal medicine and his residency in radiation oncology at the Indiana University School of Medicine. He served as the chief resident at Indiana University and was a member of the Graduate Medical Education Committee. Dr. Brabham has extensive training and clinical experience in 3D-CRT, IMRT, IGRT, proton therapy, gynecologic brachytherapy, and SBRT/SABR therapy. He is certified in radiation oncology by the American Board of Radiology.
